The Comptroller of the Treasury's Division of County Audit today released the Review of Funds Administered by District Attorneys General and Judicial District Task Forces: 1<sup>st</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial Districts for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2008.

The auditors had findings in nine judicial districts. The findings and recommendations for corrective action were reviewed with the district attorneys general and representatives of the drug task forces. The details, including responses from the district attorneys general and task force representatives, are presented in the Findings, Recommendations and Financial Section of the report.
